2017 Champions Cup Update:

Just a very short note to advise you, as a 2017 Champions Cup Invitational competitor, that we have a full field and a substantial waitlist for this year's competition.

This year's field will be our most competitive field in history, with a +2.6 average handicap of the 104 competitors. Our 2017 competitors have very seasoned playing resumes, including USGA Amateur and USGA Mid-Amateur events, as well as other national amateur events and multiple individual clubs and state championships.

We are proud to announce that our guest speaker at the Thursday night "Players Dinner" will be 1981 USGA Amateur Champion Nathaniel Crosby.

Nathaniel also won the Porter Cup in 1982, low amateur at the 1982 U.S. Open, won the 1982 Eisenhower Trophy and member of the 1983 Walker Cup team. He turned professional in 1984 and played the European Tour from 1985 to 1987. In 1988 Nathaniel turned his attention to the business side of golf, becoming involved in golf club manufacturing companies and golf real estate. Regaining his amateur status in 1994, he played again in the Porter Cup and U.S. Amateur. Nathaniel has also just completed a wonderful book "18 Holes with Bing" in which he shares exclusive stories about his father golfing, working, and playing with some of the most famous people in history—including Jack Burke Jr., Bob Hope, Dwight Eisenhower, Ben Hogan, Jack Nicklaus, Louis Armstrong, and many others.
