Champions Golf Club update regarding Novel Coronavirus COVID-19 and the 53rd Champions Cup Invitational

Champions Golf Club is very mindful of concerns regarding the Novel Coronavirus COVID-19 in light of the Champions Cup Invitational being held in three weeks in Houston, Texas. Our number one priority is the health and safety of our tournament teams, volunteers, players, fans, sponsors and anyone associated with the event.

We continue to monitor the developing situation closely through updates from the Centers for Disease Control and local Government health advisories. Based upon current knowledge and their recommendations on planning for mass gatherings, we are proceeding as scheduled with the Champions Cup Invitational, April 2nd-5th, 2020. We will continue to review the available information from authorities and take appropriate action as advised.

Champions Golf Club's position is consistent with the PGA Tour's decision at this time to proceed as scheduled with the WGC-Dell Technologies Match Play in Austin; the week before the Cup (March 6th Statement). Also, at this time, the Valero Texas Open in San Antonio is still scheduled for the same week as the Cup.

To-date, the greater Houston area has only a limited amount of people affected by the virus, primarily from travelers to the area. The Houston Livestock & Rodeo is in full swing through March 22nd, attracting hundreds of thousands of people.
